

Top Load PowrDipper® Drop

Teat spray efficiency with teat cup coverage

The Top Load PowrDipper Drop (solution hose is attached to the top) was designed to be used in a parlor type milking barn. The drop is suspended from overhead and generally will service two milking stalls in a herringbone designed milking parlor. If the top load drop is to be used in a side-opener type parlor, then one drop per stall would be recommended. Flat barns make use of the RJB Flat Barn Drop and parallel parlors generally use the RJB Bottom Load Drop.

Because the PowrDipper hangs in an upright position, the milker has easy access to the dipping tool and is more likely to dip the cows than not. The milker merely grabs the pistol grip handle, pulls the trigger and proceeds to dip all four teats by pushing the cup all the way up to the base of the udder while the trigger is held open. The patented PowrDipper will coat the teats with sanitizer from the tips to the base of the udder.

When used with an RJB teat dip pump, field studies have shown that an RJB PowrDipper system can save up to 75%* in teat dip usage as compared to spraying
