

# Top Load PowrSprayer Drop



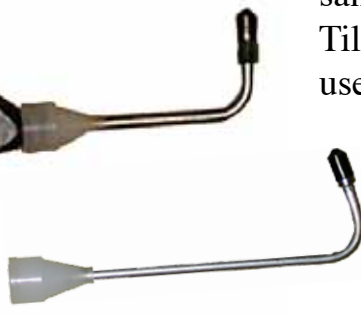
In the rough environment of a modern high production milking parlor, the teat sprayer gets heavy duty service. Its valve is opened at least twice per cow, and when milking hundreds, maybe thousands, of cows three times per day, the teat spray gun gets a hard workout. The RJB PowrSprayer was designed for just this type of environment.

The PowrSprayer has the same handle and trigger mechanism as our other delivery system, the PowrDipper. Glass reinforced nylon and molybdenum plastic form the building blocks of these rugged tools.

The PowrSprayer wand is made of rugged, heavy stainless steel and features a removable fixed-spray nozzle that points straight up to spray the ends and back sides of the teats.

The spray gun is suspended from overhead in an upright position, making it ideal for herringbone type parlors. This also insures that the milker can only hold the gun one way, with the nozzle always pointing up at the teat ends, helping to eliminate shadow spraying of the teats.

The new Tilt-Back wand helps to ensure that sanitizer is put on the back side of the teats. The Tilt-Back Wand is 10 inches long and is very useful in the parallel parlor where teat spraying is usually done through the cows back legs. The Tilt-Back Wand can be attached to any Top or Bottom Load PowrSprayer or PowrDipper gun. A 10 inch long wand with a 90 degree bend is also available.
