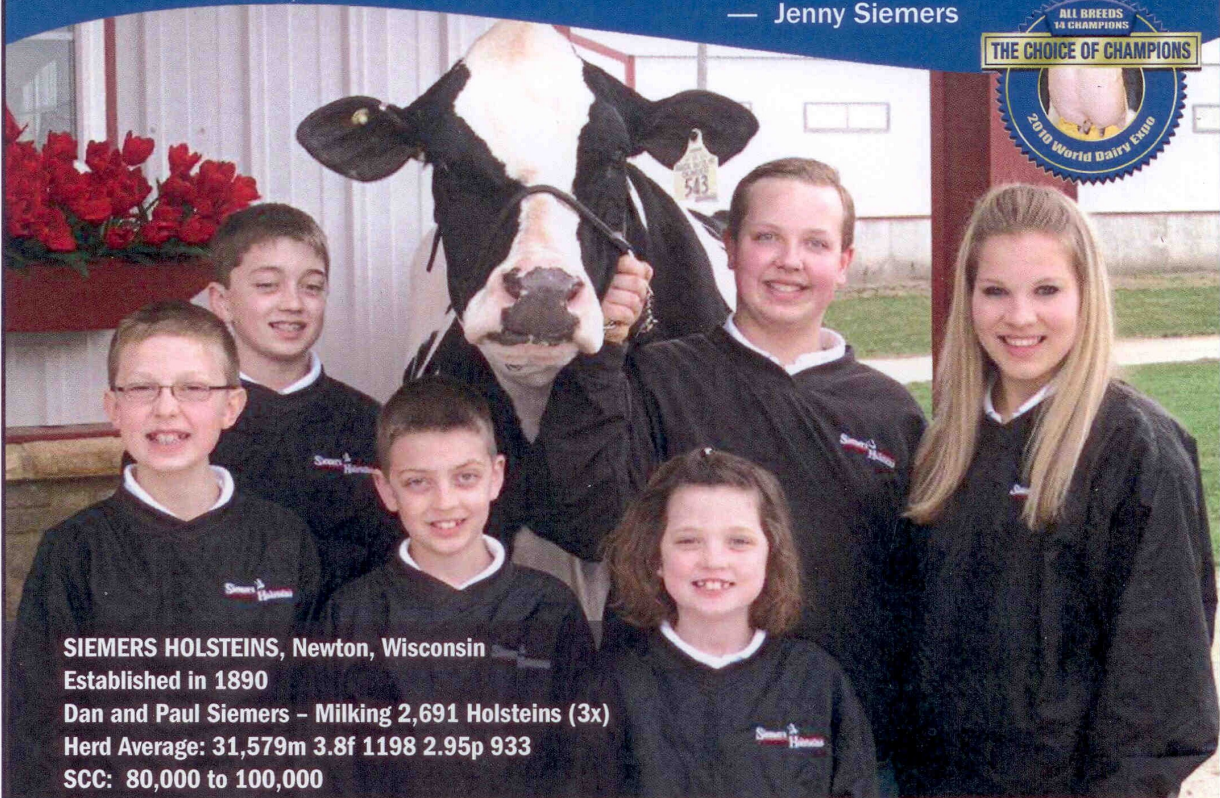
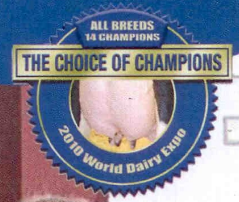

"We are firm believers in Udder Comfort™. After 4 years of using it primarily on mastitis cows, we now use it generously on prefresh groups to target udder edema and increase comfort levels.
