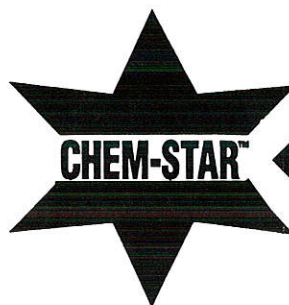
## USE

### CLEANING PIPELINES AND MILKING UNITS

1. Pre-flush pipeline and milking units with a large volume of clear tap water.
2. Prepare cleaning solution using 1 oz. of *Dissolve Gold™* to each 3 gallons (2.5 g/L) of hot water (starting temperature 160°F/71°C.) (Do not guess at amount of water. Measure and put mark on tank.)
3. Circulate cleaning solution through system for 8 to 10 minutes, brush-washing all parts not coming in contact with circulating solution. Wear rubber gloves when brush-washing equipment.
4. Rinse equipment with potable water.
5. Rinse with solution containing a *Chem-Star™ CIP Acid™* at 1 oz. to 10 to 12 gallons of water.
6. Sanitize prior to use with an approved EPA registered Chem-Star sanitizer.
