Dear Registrant:

The Office of Pesticide Programs acknowledges receipt of EPA form 8570-5, Notice of Supplemental Distributor of a Registered Pesticide Product. Attached is a copy of the EPA pin-punched form for your records.

Consistent with 40 C.F.R. 152.132, you are responsible for the distribution of your product. Your distributors are your agents for all intents and purposes under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), and you both may be held liable for violations pertaining to the distributor product. For example, make sure your distributors have the latest EPA approved label for your product and are notified of any labeling or registration changes involving your product. Further, you may be held liable for FIFRA violations such as sale and distribution of a misbranded pesticide, which can include a product having a false or misleading name or sale, and distribution of a pesticide the composition of which differs from what is described on your Confidential Statement of Formula. You are responsible for ensuring that your distributors comply with the terms of an EPA cancellation order or a voluntary cancellation notice pursuant to 40 C.F.R. §152.132(e).

A copy of this notice will be maintained by EPA, however the brand name of the distributor product on this notice has not been reviewed for compliance with the FIFRA requirements.

If your distribution agreement with a distributor ends at any time, EPA requests you notify the Agency by letter on company letterhead.

When notifying the Agency that a supplemental distributor relationship has ended, please include the following in the subject line and body of the letter:


"Notification of Termination of Supplemental Distributor Agreement" followed

by the PRODUCT NUMBER including the distributor company number for which the relationship has ended.

When notifying the Agency of changes to the brand name of a supplemental distributor product, the following should be included in the subject line and body of the requested letter:

"Notification of [Removal and/or Change] of Distributor Product Name"
followed by the PRODUCT NAME you would like removed or changed.

Notice of Supplemental Distribution of a Registered Pesticide Product

Instructions

After a registrant has obtained final registration for the basic product, the registrant may then supplementally distribute his/her product. One form must be submitted for each distributor product and must be signed by the distributor involved. The basic registration number and the distributor company number must be shown.

If a registrant has a potential distributor who does not have a company number assigned, she/he should have the distributor apply, on letterhead stationery, to the Registration Division to have a number assigned prior to submitting this form to the agency.

This Notice of Supplemental Distribution must be submitted by the basic registrant. The completed form must have the concurrence and signature of both the registrant and the distributor.

Read All Conditions Before Signing

1. The distributor product must have the same composition as the basic product.
2. The distributor product must be manufactured and packaged by the same person who manufactures and packages the registered basic product.
3. The labeling for the distributor product must bear the same claims as the basic product, provided, however, that specific claims may be deleted if by doing so, no other changes to the label are necessary.
4. The product must remain in the manufacturer's unbroken container.
5. The label must bear the EPA registration number of the basic product, followed by a hyphen and the distributor's company number.
6. Distributor product labels must bear the name and address of the distributor qualified by such terms as "packed for...", "distributed by..."; or "sold by..." to show that the name is not that of the manufacturer.
7. All conditions of the basic registration apply equally to distributor products. It is the responsibility of the basic registrant to see that all distributor labeling is kept in compliance with requirements placed on the basic product.
