#### **USAGE GUIDELINES**

#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

Turn on the vacuum system. When operating vacuum has been achieved, place the open end of the flushing tube into the container of **CLEAN-A-LOBE**.

Allow the product to be drawn into the pump.

Continue running the pump for 10 minutes after the moisture stops coming from the pump exhaust. Turn off the vacuum pump until the next milking.
